# **Playing Times**

- All Sections shall play 10 minute quarters.



# Affiliation

- All Clubs that compete in the Northern Football Netball League are required to be an incorporated Club.
- Competing Clubs are not required to be aligned with a Northern Football Netball League Club.







## Membership

- All players must be registered with the Northern Football Netball League on SportsTG, AND hold a current Netball Victoria Membership (VNA).
- As our season commences in 2018, players can play in Summer Competition under their 2018 VNA membership.
- Once season has been completed, a 2019 VNA Membership must be bought for main season.
- Single game VNA passes are available at all venues @ \$10.00 per game



## Transfers

- A player wishing to play with another club in the summer must apply for a transfer.
- Transfer may be denied if a player is not financial (owes money to their previous club) or has not returned club property.
- At completion of summer season, a player must again apply for a transfer if they wish to return to their previous winter club.

#### Coaches

- All coaches must have completed the foundation netball coaching course (or be booked in to take the course) in order to coach in the Northern Football Netball League.
- Further coaching education courses are provided by the Northern Football Netball League via Netball Victoria.
