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Task Profile	<p>The Representative Netball Coach will be responsible for:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Leading the NFNL Representative team, in a coaching capacity, in pursuit of its competitive and development objectives. • Ensure that players are provided with direct learning at a practical level through individual, specialist and team coaching instruction. • Introduce players to varied approaches to learning. • Supervise, support and mentor the assistant coach in both training and competition environment. • Determine in consultation with the NFNL Head Coach, coaching requirements for the team. • Develop, implement and adapt match play strategies. • Provide coaching instruction to players in the areas of technique, positional skills and team skills. • Evaluate and assess individual and team performance, ensuring individuals are appropriately challenged and provided with constructive feedback. • Take appropriate action to ensure underperformance is effectively dealt with. • Abide by NFNL Policies and Procedures. • Attend all trials, training sessions, and competitions of the team.
