## Auskick Co-ordinator

### PURPOSE:

The Auskick Co-ordinator role provides support to DCJFC Auskick program and encourages the involvement of girls in football.

### OBJECTIVES:

- To act as contact point and provide support for female Auskick players wishing to transition to DCWFC
- To support the DCJFC Auskick program
- To act as a mentor to DCWFC players volunteering with the program

### RESPONSIBILITIES:

- To promote and recruit a list of DCWFC U14 to U18 players to support the DCJFC Auskick program
- Provide support and encouragement to DCWFC volunteers
- Contribute information regarding Auskick to the DCWFC newsletter and socials
- Promote Auskick across DCWFC
- Attend the Friday night Auskick program and assist where required
- Uphold and actively promote club values throughout the Club as a whole
- Provide a report on portfolio operations at the monthly General Committee meetings
- Be committed to and identify any opportunities to further grow the DCWFC and its members into the future
- Report on activities of the portfolio to the membership at the Annual General Meeting
- Seek ratification from the appropriate Committee member prior to committing the Club to any financial expenditure or action
- Provide feedback to the Committee at the end of season on improvement opportunities
- Undertake other tasks related to this role that may not be noted
