# Chair

# On behalf of the Board of Directors of the Northern Football Netball League I present the League's Annual Report for 2025.

Firstly, I would like to thank everyone who is associated with the Northern Football Netball League, in any way, large or small for the contribution you make to such a vibrant community-based league and our football and netball competitions.

Club and community committees and stakeholders, who volunteer their time, are critical to the enduring sustainability, growth and success of our competitions. These people make NFNL achievements possible.

Thank you to all our football and netball participants, Seniors and Juniors, Men and Women, Boys and Girls. The enthusiasm and passion the NFNL's players bring to the field and court week-in and week-out is infectious, enjoyable to be a part of and connects people to their clubs and broader community in a way that is about more than the games we compete in.

Thank you also to the many club coaching and support personnel who make it possible for so many people to participate, whether coaching first time players, just starting in junior football and netball, to coaching our highly experienced and accomplished senior footballers and netballers.

The dedicated NFNL staff and team of football and netball umpires' contribution is also invaluable to the NFNL success and positive standing in the community.

The ongoing success of the league and our clubs is also dependent on the contributions made by sponsors and partners. Having such reputable organisations supporting and partnering with the NFNL is another reflection of the league's positive community reputation.

2025 yet again set overall participation records for the NFNL. Just under 5,000 players participated in senior football and netball throughout the 2025 season.

We again were witnesses to some compelling team and individual performances across our thriving and vibrant competitions.

In Football, Heidelberg continued their recent dominance of the Melbourne Greyhounds Division 1 Men's competition with a 4th consecutive senior premiership and for the second year in a row the club also secured the Reserves and Under-19.5 premierships. Congratulations also to Hurstbridge, who for the first time in the club's history played off

in the Division 1 Grand Final. The Division 1 Finals Series returned to Epping Recreation Reserve for the first time in around 20 years. A big thank you to the Epping Football Netball Club Committee and the team for their work in hosting.

In the MC Labour Division 2 Men's competition Diamond Creek achieved premiership success with a commanding performance. The home and away season proved to be a tight three-way battle at the top of the ladder between Diamond Creek, Macleod and Whittlesea, with Diamond Creek ultimately recording a strong win against Macleod on Grand Final Day to secure the premiership and a place in Division 1 for 2026. Thank you to Lalor Football Netball Club for hosting the Division 2 finals so successfully, with more than 3,000 spectators on Grand Final Day.

In Heidelberg Golf Club Division 3 Men's the Fitzroy Stars won their first Senior Premiership in the NFNL era. The Stars had an outstanding season, undefeated in the home and away rounds and losing only once in the 2nd semi-final before winning the Premiership against Laurimar in a strong performance. Thomastown Football Netball Club hosted the Division 3 finals, thank you to all club officials and volunteers for your efforts throughout the finals, catering for a crowd of over 3,000 on Grand Final Day.

In 2025 the Women's football lead up finals were played at La Trobe University for the first time. It was wonderful to showcase the best of our Senior Women's football at such a great facility.

In a great grand final day Eltham Central Park played host to our Senior Women's football Grand Finals in front of large crowds throughout the day. Thank you to the Eltham Football Club Committee and volunteers for their organisation on Grand Final Day.

The largest margin of the grand finals contested at Eltham was 13 points with all 3 games proving to be very tight contests until very late in each game.

In the Heidelberg Golf Club Division 1
Women's Grand Final, Diamond Creek
Women's defeated Montmorency to take out
the Premiership. Diamond Creek Women's
savoured their win after getting very close
12 months ago. Diamond Creek Women's led
all day, managing to hold off a fast-finishing
Montmorency, much to the joy of their
supporters.

In the Cleaning Melbourne Division 2 Women's Grand Final, Lower Plenty made it back-to-back premierships with their defeat of Fitzroy Stars. Lower Plenty led all day





however the Stars were always in the game, reducing a 22 point half time deficit to just 8 points at the final change before Lower settled to secure consecutive premierships.

The Division 3 Women's football Grand Final saw North Heidelberg defeat Heidelberg West by 9 points to secure their first Women's premiership. The game was tight all day with the margin never getting beyond 10 points.

In 2025 the NFNL also achieved recognition as a Women and Girls Chartered League. The Charter is underpinned by 4 guiding principles, Opportunity, Visibility, Access and Investment to set the future standards for how we champion female participations and leadership in football.

In season 2025 over 4,500 boys and 1,500 girls played junior football in the NFNL. 24 clubs fielded a total of 267 teams across all age groups. Across our Junior Football Grand Finals, 17 different clubs were represented. Congratulations to all those who tasted premiership success in our Junior Football competitions.

The 2025 Cleaning Melbourne Winter Netball Season included 133 teams playing across 15 Divisions, at multiple venues in the North.

Netball Premier Divisions 1, 2 and 3 was again a showcase of elite netball. In Premier Division 1 North Heidelberg won the premiership in commanding style, with Banyule securing the premiership in Premier Division 2. While Kinglake won the Premier Division 3 premiership following a nail-biting contest played out in extra time.

Just on 2,000 people attended our two Fridays of Winter Season Netball Grand Finals at our premier venue, the La Trobe University Sports Complex.

The NFNL Summer Netball 2024 – 2025 season also reflected the continuing growth and development of netball as a year round fixture in the North. With the Senior Summer season seeing over 100 teams playing across 13 Divisions.

NFNL Junior Netball continued an annual pattern of growth and expansion across both the Summer and Winter season. 49 teams, across all age groups, participated throughout the Winter season, an increase of 17 teams. Additionally, 6 players from the NFNL representative teams have been identified for participation in the Netball Victoria Talent Pathway Program, an important part of the NFNL's Netball Victoria affiliation.

As part of the NFNL 2024 – 2028 Strategic Plan the critical role of umpires to the success and sustainability of our Football and Netball competitions was reinforced.

Throughout 2025 we have continued to build and develop umpiring numbers and capabilities across both Senior and Junior Football and Netball. Particular thanks to our continuing umpires and a warm welcome to those who have joined the NFNL umpiring ranks throughout 2025.

Thank you again to the dedicated staff team and the ongoing contribution to the successful operations of the NFNL.

The NFNL saw a number of staffing changes throughout the 2025 season.

In October the Board accepted Martin Stillman's resignation as Chief Executive Officer after three years in the role.

We would like to thank Martin for his contribution to the NFNL over that time, in particular leading the development and implementation of the 2024 – 2028 Strategic Plan. We wish Martin well in his future endeavours.

Jennifer Phefley moved into the role of General Manager of Football Operations early in 2025 and has established sound working relationships with our clubs and the football operations team. The football operations team also welcomed Ashley White looking after Junior Football, Darren Bassett as Umpire Manager and Lachlan Brown in football administration.

We also welcomed Luke Paramanathan as Club Engagement Lead who has worked to support clubs to build operational capabilities.

Our Netball competitions continue to go from strength to strength under the leadership of Lauren Theodosis as General Manager of Netball and Taylah Howie, coordinating our Netball Programs.

The organisation has also benefited with the commencement of Office Manager Fiona Crapper, known to many in the North.

Our Finance Team of Byron Smith and Joanne Timewell continued their rigorous financial management.

During 2025 Jeff Downes, Nicholas Sacco, Robert Comley and Josh Ward left the NFNL, moving to different roles in other organisations. We would like to thank them for their contribution and service to the NFNL. It was pleasing to have the professional tones of Nicholas on hand as Master of Ceremonies at both the Junior Presentation and Rosbrook Medal nights.

The Board of Directors has also undergone a number of changes over the past year. Scott Walker stepped down as Board Chair following the 2024 Annual General Meeting, subsequently resigning from the Board in 2025 to take on a coaching role with Panton Hill Football Netball Club's women's team. Scott's service and guidance to the Board was exceptional, in particular, guiding the league through the unprecedented challenges of the 2020 and 2021 pandemic disruptions.

John Anderson stepped down from the Board at the end of 2024. John served as Deputy Chair and was a valuable member of the Finance Committee.

Consistent with the Board's established skill-based Board renewal approach, the Board welcomed 2 new Board Directors during the 2025 season. Our 2 new Board Directors, Andrew Smith and Paul Millett, bring valuable professional skill sets to the Board. In addition, both are well known identities in the Northern Football Netball League, bringing a sound understanding of our league, from both a historical and future growth perspective. Our new Board Directors joined continuing Directors, Paul McInerney, Nicolina Lademann, Chelsa Robson and Cherie Kelly.

The NFNL continue to be supported by a large number of corporate and community sponsorships and partnerships, integral to NFNL success and sustainability.

# **Football Operations**

The 2025 season was one of change and growth for football in the North, with continued success across three senior men's divisions, three senior women's divisions, and 37 junior competitions, alongside significant changes within league staff.

For the second consecutive year, the NFNL exceeded 10,000 registered players — including over 3,000 senior players (Men, Women, and Under 19.5) and more than 5,900 juniors. These numbers highlight the ongoing strength of our Women's and Junior competitions. Nearly 900 accredited coaches and over 1,400 volunteers also contributed to the success of the season, reflecting the depth of commitment across our football community

The 2025 finals series underwent a significant revamp, with matches returning to community venues. Each division's finals were proudly hosted by NFNL clubs, reinforcing our league's community focus. We extend our sincere thanks to the Eltham, Epping, Lalor, and Thomastown football clubs — and their volunteers — for their outstanding efforts in hosting the 2025 finals.

Working with our major partner, La Trobe University, the NFNL launched the Senior Women's finals series at La Trobe's sporting precinct, creating a dedicated home for women's football in Melbourne's northern suburbs. The weekend showcased the

depth of women's talent across the league, with the Division 1 Junior Girls finals played alongside the Senior Women's preliminary finals — a fitting celebration of the game's future.

On Sunday, August 24, Eltham Central Park hosted three closely fought Women's Grand Finals, each decided by under 15 points. North Heidelberg defeated Heidelberg West by nine points, Lower Plenty overcame Fitzroy Stars by 13 points in Division 2, and Diamond Creek Women's secured redemption in Division 1 — a nine-point victory over Montmorency following the heartbreak of their 2024 Grand Final loss.

Two weeks later, Thomastown hosted the Division 3 finals, highlighted by Laurimar and Fitzroy Stars meeting in both the Reserves and Seniors premierships. Despite a significant injury delay, both contests were fiercely fought. Fitzroy Stars triumphed in the Seniors match to claim their first premiership in 35 years, while Laurimar secured the Reserves title. Kilmore also prevailed in the Marbuilt Under 19.5 Division 3 premiership, defeating Bundoora.







Lalor hosted the Division 2 finals, where in the MC Labour Division 2 Seniors Grand Final Diamond Creek proved to be too strong for Macleod in a 107 point victory. A performance that will give them the confidence stepping up into Division 1 in 2026. Unfortunately Diamond Creek were unable to secure the double with Whittlesea defeating their Reserves team and subsequently Whittlesea's Under 19.5 team were defeated by North Heidelberg.

Finally Epping played host to the Division 1 finals where the headline Melbourne Greyhounds Division 1 Seniors Grand Final featured Heidelberg pursuing a fourth straight premiership against Hurstbridge, who had made an inspired run from fifth place to reach their first Division 1 Grand Final. Heidelberg proved why they remain the benchmark of community football, winning by 81 points and securing a clean sweep with victories in both the Marbuilt Under 19.5 and Reserves competitions.

While football is built on teamwork, the NFNL proudly acknowledges the outstanding individual performances of 2025. Heidelberg's Tom Keys became a back-to-back Rosbrook Medallist, while South Morang's Hayley Cordova followed up her 2024 Division 3 Best & Fairest win with both the Division 2 Coaches MVP and Best & Fairest medals.

Macleod's Darcy Barden kicked 102 goals in the MC Labour Division 2 competition, and Diamond Creek Women's star Linda Thorpe claimed her fifth consecutive leading goalkicker title in the Heidelberg Golf Club Division 1 Senior Women's competition.

Junior football continues to thrive, with 4,524 boys and 1,406 girls participating across 37 divisions, from Under 9s through to Under 17.5 Boys and Under 18 Girls. The 2025 final series were played across 13 venues (Research, Yarrambat, Wallan, Mernda, Mill Park, Hurstbridge, Kilmore, Eltham, Old Paradians & La Trobe) where 20 of the eligible 22 clubs featured in finals with 17 of those clubs progressing through to Grand Finals. Grading and fixturing across 37 divisions remains a complex challenge,





and the league is committed to exploring innovative approaches to streamline these processes.

The NFNL's Junior Development Academy continued to evolve in 2025, building on the strong foundations of previous years. A total of 356 players participated in trials, guided by an independent coaching panel in collaboration with the Northern Knights. The Academy proudly represented the league in the AFL Victoria Metropolitan Junior Development Series (MJDS) with teams in Under 15 Boys, Under 14 Boys, and Under 15 Girls.

Special congratulations to our NFNL Development Academy MVP winners; Darcy Tabain (Under 15 Boys Div 1), Adam Reginato Jnr (Under 15 Boys Div 2), Grace Robinson (Under 15 Girls Div 1), Sklya Robinson (Under 15 Girls Div 2), Tadg Anver (Under 14 Boys Div 1) & Billy Brundell (Under 14 Boys Div 2).

The NFNL remains committed to fostering junior development and creating a stable, growth-focused environment that nurtures the next generation of senior players across both Men's and Women's competitions.

The 2025 season marked the first within the NFNL for the current Football Department staff, and we extend our sincere thanks to all clubs for their cooperation, support, and engagement as we established ourselves within the league.

We also express our deep appreciation to club presidents, secretaries, football managers, coaches, and the countless volunteers whose tireless efforts sustain community football. Your dedication underpins the continued success of the NFNL.

We look forward to building on the progress and spirit of 2025 as we head into what promises to be an exciting 2026 season.

# **Netball Operations**

The 2025 season has been a year of outstanding growth, innovation, and community connection for NFNL Netball, with record participation across all levels and new initiatives introduced to enhance the professionalism and sustainability of our competitions.

We are proud of the progress made both on and off the court, thanks to the dedication of our clubs, coaches, umpires, players, and volunteers who make NFNL netball such a vibrant and inclusive community. Our sincere thanks go to Cleaning Melbourne, naming rights sponsor of the senior competition, for their continued support and investment in elevating senior netball. As we look ahead to 2026, the NFNL remains committed to fostering growth, supporting our clubs, and ensuring our competitions continue to embody the values of belonging, integrity, respect and accountability.

We were pleased to welcome Taylah Howie to the team as Netball Operations Coordinator this year. She has quickly settled into her role and made a significant contribution to the league, particularly through her work in managing the junior netball competition. In addition, Taylah has provided valuable support across a range of

programs, including umpiring, representative netball, NetSetGO, and senior netball operations.

Thank you to Ann Castles for her ongoing work with the umpiring team in developing and supporting our officials.

The 2024–25 Senior Summer Competition experienced outstanding growth, with team numbers increasing to 104, representing a 13% increase on the previous year. This continued growth highlights the strong demand for year-round netball competitions within the NFNL. A new 17&U competition was introduced alongside senior netball on Friday nights, providing an important transitional pathway between junior and senior levels. We extend our thanks to the inaugural participating clubs of Bundoora, Diamond Creek, Fitzroy Stars, and Montmorency for their support in establishing this new competition. The

2024–25 Junior Summer Competition mirrored this growth, increasing to 38 teams, up 15% from the previous summer season. Congratulations to all premiership-winning teams across both senior and junior summer competitions.

The 2025 Winter Season marked the introduction of a new competition structure for senior netball divisions 1–3, featuring a promotion and relegation system that enables movement between divisions based on performance. These divisions were rebranded as the Premier Netball Competitions and benefited from enhanced NFNL media coverage and event activations. This structure also created greater alignment with football fixtures where possible, further strengthening community connection and club engagement.

The NFNL was delighted to welcome Banyule FNC to senior netball for the first time in 2025, enjoying a highly successful debut season that culminated in promotion to Division 1. Participation once again reached record levels, with 134 teams entered in the open competition, and eight teams in the 17&U division, representing a 14.5% increase compared to the 2024 winter season. To accommodate this growth, the competition expanded to include a 15th division, underscoring the NFNL's position as one of Victoria's most sought-after netball competitions. We also welcomed Casa D'Abruzzo Club as a new competition venue, providing a centrally located and highquality facility for clubs.

In support of the new minimum coaching requirements for the Cleaning Melbourne Premier Division 1 competition, the NFNL delivered a Netball Victoria Development Coaching Accreditation Course, reinforcing our commitment to continuous improvement and excellence at the elite community level.

The 2025 Junior Winter Competition saw substantial growth, with 43 teams competing across 9&U to 15&U age groups, a remarkable 59% increase compared to 2024. In line with this growth, the league invested heavily in coaching development programs to ensure clubs are well supported in developing young players. NFNL Coach Mentor Pauline McLaren provided one on one mentoring for coaches at Hurstbridge JFC and Donnybrook FNC, while Coach Developer Richelle McKenzie delivered a workshop on Rolling Substitutions and Tactical Changes.





The league continued to benefit from its strong partnership with La Trobe University, welcoming a student intern to assist with netball administration and gain hands-on experience in the operations of community sport.

The league delivered a successful NetSetGO weekly program, continuing our commitment to providing an accessible entry pathway into NFNL competitions. The program plays a key role in supporting clubs by developing the foundational skills of young players and preparing them to transition into the 9&U competition upon completion. We extend our sincere thanks to Coach Bernadette Huryn for her outstanding dedication and enthusiasm in fostering the growth, confidence, and love of the game among our youngest participants.

We were excited to continue our development initiatives in the northern growth corridor, particularly in Beveridge, where a dedicated working group has been established to support the formation of a new football netball club for the future. We extend our thanks to Netball Victoria for their ongoing support of this project, and to our community champion, Vanessa Smith,

for her outstanding efforts in helping bring the club to life. The response from the local community has been very encouraging, with 13 players registering in the club's inaugural NetSetGO season.

With the ever-evolving netball landscape within the NFNL, we were delighted to host our first Senior Netball Forum since 2015, facilitated by Travis Switzer. The forum provided a valuable platform for open discussion and collaboration with clubs, and we greatly appreciate the strong level of engagement throughout the process. We look forward to continuing to apply club feedback to enhance our competitions and to help remove barriers to participation at the club level. In response to feedback gathered through the forum, we were proud to introduce a pilot Bench Official Program, allowing clubs to engage a paid scorer through the league when volunteer availability is limited. This initiative has been well received and supports clubs in meeting their match day obligations more effectively.

Our engagement around the Sir Douglas Nicholls Round continued in partnership with the Fitzroy Stars FNC. We extend our thanks to Shara Graham and Samantha Saunders for their invaluable contributions to the events. We were privileged to have the Nunkeri Tiddas dance group deliver a captivating pre-match performance at junior netball, complemented by a didgeridoo performance at senior netball, and a moving Acknowledgement of Country from Aunty Esme Bamblett. Videography captured throughout the round enabled us to reach wider audiences online, highlighting the featured match between the Fitzroy Stars and Greensborough, and celebrating the 2025 NAIDOC theme: The Next Generation – Strength, Vision & Legacy.

The 2025 season also saw greater exposure for netball across audio platforms through the newly established Baseline Banter podcast, produced by volunteers Iris Bentley and Bella Collodetti. We thank them for their ongoing efforts in promoting our netball community and commend the engaging, light-hearted approach of the podcast, which continues to strengthen connection and visibility for our grassroots athletes.

The NFNL Representative Netball Program had another successful and engaging year, made possible through the dedication of our coaching and support team. We extend

our sincere thanks to our coaches Kendra Vann, Sharlah McBain, Zoe Draper, Mia Llewellyn, Kate Arnot, Lynsey Barrett, Helena Toklis, Stacey Gannon, Lisa McBain, and Tristan Goldsmith for their time, passion, and expertise in developing our athletes. Special thanks also go to Trainer Josh Ferris, Program Coordinator Jaynaya Wharton, and Carla Muscat for their invaluable assistance at training sessions, and to Head Coach Brooke George for her leadership and guidance across the entire program.

Our 13&U team proudly represented the league at both the Essendon District and Mountain Districts tournaments, while all NFNL representative teams from 11&U through to 17&U competed in the Altona Netball Association Tournament, providing valuable match experience and exposure to high-quality competition.

We were fortunate to partner with La Trobe Sport, who hosted a fantastic teambuilding session for our 11&U and 13&U squads. Players participated in activities including rock climbing, table tennis, and an on-court skills session at the La Trobe Indoor Sports Centre — an experience that helped strengthen team connection and foster a sense of unity among our youngest representatives.

In preparation for the Association Championships, our teams benefited from a series of practice matches with AFL Outer East and Darebin Netball Association, which





provided excellent opportunities to refine skills and team structures ahead of the competition. We also hosted an 11&U Round Robin Day, inviting players from member clubs to join the NFNL representative squad for a training and match play session. This initiative allowed aspiring athletes to experience the representative environment firsthand and promoted greater understanding and visibility of the program within our community.

Additionally, our 15&U to Open Age athletes participated in the SALT Mental Health and Wellbeing Program, an important initiative that supports players' off-court development by encouraging resilience, mindfulness, and positive team culture.

We are extremely proud of the continued growth and professionalism of our representative program, and we thank everyone involved for their dedication in creating meaningful and high-quality experiences for our athletes.

I would like to extend my sincere thanks to my colleagues for their dedication, professionalism, and support throughout the year. Your collective efforts behind the scenes ensure the continued success of our competitions, programs, and events, and your commitment to growing and supporting the game across our community is truly appreciated. Thank you for another outstanding year.

This year, we hosted a Netball Victoria Advanced Mentoring Course, designed to further equip our mentors with the tools to support umpires progressing from C grade to B grade accreditation.

Additionally, we introduced our own Umpire Observation Workshop, where developing umpires had the opportunity to observe our top officials in a division 1 match and participate in real-time discussions with an umpire coach. ## **Club Development**

Building on the strong foundations established in 2024, the NFNL has continued to expand and strengthen its commitment to club development, ensuring our clubs are well-supported both on and off the field.

LATROP

The NFNL became a Women & Girls Chartered League in 2025, recognising our commitment to creating safe, inclusive, and welcoming environments for women and girls in community football. By joining the Women & Girls Community Football Charter, the NFNL reaffirms its dedication to supporting opportunities for women and girls to participate, lead, and thrive across all levels of the game.

Over the past year, we have developed stronger relationships with a range of valued partners. This includes new partnerships with Outside the Locker Room, Child Safety Australia, Evolve Education, and First Aid Management, as well as the continuation of our successful partnerships with Tackle Your Feelings, the Pat Cronin Foundation, SALT, and the Carlton Football Club. Their expertise and support have been instrumental in enabling the delivery of high-quality education, wellbeing, and safety programs across our network.

We would also like to extend our appreciation to Malcolm Bangs (Tackles & Takedowns) for facilitating an outstanding women's and girls' coach education session, which has further enhanced the capability and confidence of our coaching community.

In addition, the NFNL has continued to advocate for our clubs and build stronger relationships with our seven local councils: Mitchell Shire, Banyule, Darebin, Murrindindi Shire, Nillumbik, and Whittlesea. We thank each council for their ongoing support and collaboration, and we are excited about the opportunities these partnerships will create as we move into the 2026 season and beyond.


With the support of AFL Victoria, the NFNL has successfully injected over \$100,000 into our clubs through various funding programs, grants, and initiatives- a significant increase from the previous year. These investments have provided clubs with access to expert-

led programs, essential funding, and vital resources. This includes child safety education, governance training, and support in recruiting and retaining volunteers. This support will continue to grow into 2026, and we extend our sincere thanks to AFL Victoria for their ongoing commitment to community football

As outlined in the Football Operations Report, we have seen a significant increase in both senior and junior participation numbers. Most pleasingly, several clubs that previously did not field senior women's or junior teams have now established strong programs in 2025. This growth is a testament to the tireless efforts of our dedicated volunteers.

We have continued working on building new participation pathways in Beveridge and Wollert to support the rapid growth of these communities. These initiatives aim to create strong local opportunities for both football







and netball, ensuring players of all ages and abilities can get involved, stay active, and progress through the sport. By investing in these emerging areas, the NFNL is helping to establish vibrant, sustainable clubs that will serve as the foundation for future generations of players and volunteers in the Northern Corridor.

Throughout 2025, the league delivered a range of workshops and resources designed to support club committees, coaches, and team managers, ensuring they have the tools and confidence to effectively lead their clubs. We extend our sincere thanks to every volunteer who continues to give their time and energy to strengthen our football and netball communities and work closely with the NFNL to advance not only their clubs, but also the league.

As we move into 2026 and beyond, the NFNL remains focused on innovation and continuous improvement. The league is exploring opportunities to streamline administrative processes, modernise digital systems, and provide greater access to data-driven insights that support club planning and sustainability. Our focus will remain on building strong, inclusive, and future-ready clubs that reflect the diverse and growing communities we serve.
