

# TRIALS

## What to expect

- Match play watched by selectors
  - Selectors may give certain instructions to individual players or the entire group to assess coachability.
- Players will be asked to nominate their 2 preferred playing positions, however, be prepared to play in a position you haven't nominated as well.
- Be open minded about playing another position – the selectors may see you have long term potential in a different role.
- Depending on numbers of players trialing, there may be gaps in match play for some athletes.
- \$17.80 Fee to trial.

# TRIALS

## Rules for boys

- Boys are permitted to play, with some restrictions...

All Boys Competition	Female Competition
<b>17&amp;U Male</b> NFNL unable to field a team yet	<b>17&amp;U Female only</b> no allowances for boys
<b>15&amp;U Male</b> NFNL unable to field a team yet	<b>15&amp;U Female</b> Males less than 13 years old at the first day of the competition may participate.
<b>13&amp;U Male</b> NFNL unable to field a team yet	<b>13&amp;U Female</b> Males less than 13 years old at the first day of the competition may participate.

# LEAGUE EXPECTATIONS

- Behavioral Standards

- Abide by the NFNL player code of conduct on and off court, and through that competition year at BOTH club and representative level. Players can be removed from the program for any breaches.

- Training

- Always arrive 10 minutes prior to start time.
  - Positive attitude and encourage teammates.
  - Focus on the coach, ignore external distractions.
  - Train with the same intensity you would play with.
  - Ensure you provide 24hours notice if you cannot attend a session.

- Game Day

- The coach will put what they believe is the best team on court for each game, this can change depending on a range of factors. Players should be prepared that there may be a game where they do not take the court.

- Injuries

- Players must disclose any injuries to the coach.
  - If injured, you are still expected to attend training sessions and games as per normal unless otherwise agreed upon by the coach.
